



Cohort 2

19 Year Old Survey Results Overview

During Fiscal Year 2016, 139 youth, at age 19, completed their second National Youth in Transition Database (NYTD) survey. About 72% of youth participated in both the 17 year old and the 19 year old surveys. An overview of their responses is below:




